

Martha's Kitchen CEO Compensation

It is the practice of Martha's Kitchen to review the CEO's compensation on an annual basis. The Executive Committee comprising of the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer meets annually to review salary surveys such as the attached from the 2020 Nonprofit Compensation Associates. At the Executive Committee's sole discretion, the CEO salary may be changed based on his/her performance and in parity with equivalent sized nonprofit organizations in the Bay Area and comparable demographics. The CEO has the right to appeal by providing an explanation of the basis for appeal in writing addressed to the President of the Board of Directors. The Executive Committee has 5 business days to respond to aforementioned appeal.

Executive Director/Chief Executive Officer

Responsible to the Board of Directors for management of the entire nonprofit organization including fundraising/development, human resources, strategic planning, programs, finance and communications. Represents organization to government agencies, community and the public.
